Streamline data capture and increase productivity with new Arioform

Managers in many different industries seeking a faster, more accurate and efficient method of collecting and processing data from mobile workers will welcome the arrival of Arioform, a new digital form management solution available from Selwyn Electronics.

Suitable for any business or organisation with a mobile workforce, Arioform software eliminates the need for workers to return to the office to re-enter form data captured in the field. Instead, they simply complete forms on-site using either a digital pad or a digital pen, and then transmit the data to their office electronically. Paper copies of the form can be provided for the client or service user.

Arioform is suitable for any type of form, including health and safety checklists, surveys, maintenance reports, order forms, patient files, inventories, and meeting minutes.

Arioform is available in two versions: Arioform Enterprise and Arioform Vista.

Arioform Enterprise, which is a server-based system, is designed for use by multiple workers. It can be used to capture and process single or multi-page form data. Workers use either the DigiMemo digital pad and plain paper or a digital pen and special pre-printed paper forms, which are imprinted with a pattern which the pen recognises. The pen's built-in camera records the information as the user writes it on the form. The data can then be transmitted from the pen to the organisation's database via either a USB connection, or Bluetooth, using a Smartphone. Office-based administrators have complete control over the process, which dramatically reduces the time between data acquisition and storage and relieves pressure on office space by enabling mobile workers to carry out more data capture and validation remotely.

Arioform Vista is designed for capturing digital data on single page forms.

Workers use a DigiMemo digital pad to record the information, which can be drawn or written on the form. They can then upload the form data to their PC via USB or by Bluetooth, using a Smartphone. Form data can include tick boxes, radio buttons, boxed fields and free text fields, which can be stored graphically. Arioform Vista software also incorporates handwriting recognition technology, which enables workers to convert their handwritten forms into digital data on their PC.

Selwyn Electronics designs the digital forms, supplies the web service and/or arranges for customers to host the service securely on their own servers to ensure critical information is secure.

The Arioform Vista package costs approximately £175 ex-VAT (£85 for the software, and around £90 for the DigiMemo digital pad). Arioform Enterprise is provided as a service, customised for each purchaser. Price is quoted per project.
